As of December 16, 2009 we had \$49,600 in our bank (including investments). We provided 150 scholarships in both 2009 and 2008. Please help us raise \$17,400 by December 31, 2009 meet that goal for 2010.

Since nineteen students are planning to graduate this year we expect to have 131 HYTES students returning in 2010. We require another \$3,200 to make sure all returning students can continue school.

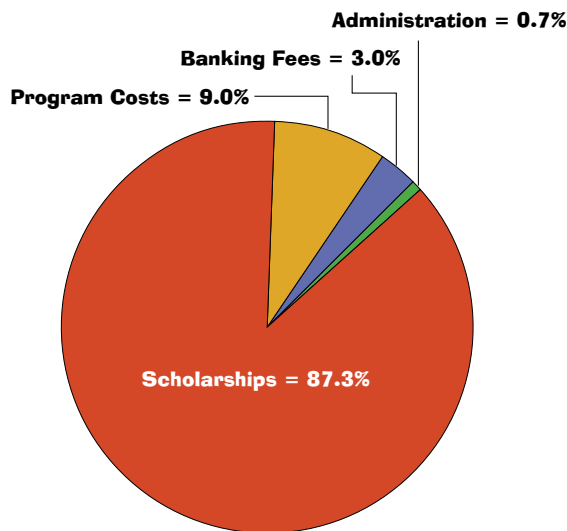

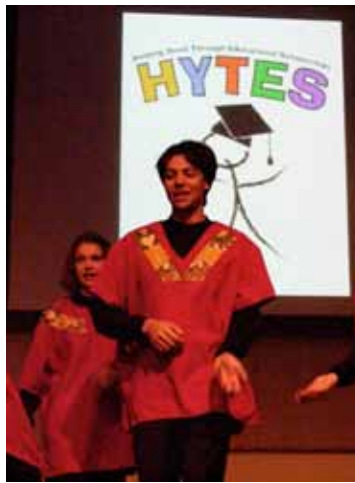
